
- A DB9 <u>null modem cable</u> (or adapter) is required when you want to connect console port to a PC with terminal emulation software such as TeraTerm.
- Turn on PC, run the terminal emulation program (e.g. *TeraTerm*), and open TeraTerm COM port.



- Set COM port at <u>Baud Rate 115200. 8 data bits. no parity. 1 stop bit and no flow control</u>.
- After the above connection/setting, you will see Linux console prompt "\$" in the PC TeraTerm.
