

If it blinks Red for 3 seconds (50ms on, 50ms off), please make solar panel to face to proper sunshine for charging to at least 90% for real application. If it doesn't blink (denotes battery has run out), please put it directly under sunshine and charge it to at least 90% for real application.



3.1 Introduction

The LT-10 is a solar LoRaWANTM tracker designed for range animal use. The high performance solar cell can provide sufficient power for continuous $LoRa^{e}$ transmission. They are the size of a standard management tag reusable GPS ear tag is powered using a battery and integrated solar cell.


4. Device Operation

4.1 Device Charging

For normal charging, the device has to be turned on and placed under sunshine to charge. It would take half day to several days to charge to at least 90% for normal application according to sunshine condition.



4.2 Switch On/Off



 To turn the device "ON", please take a proper magnet under device's LED for 4 seconds as picture above. Then it would blink Red 3 times (100ms on, 100ms off). There are two kinds of behavior as following table when the device is on.

Operation mode	Low battery mode
Take magnet under device's LED for 1	Take magnet under device's LED for 1
second and it will blink Red 1 time	second and it will blink Red 1 time

- To turn the device "OFF", please take a proper magnet under device's LED for 4 seconds. Then it would blink Red 3 times (100ms on, 100ms off).
 Noted: Take magnet under device LED for 1 second and it has no LED blink.
- 3. To do hardware reset, Take magnet under device's LED over 11 seconds and it would blink Red for 3 seconds (50ms on, 50ms off).



- 1. When it is in low battery mode, it could not join to network server and send any report. It could not modify device settings via App as well.
- 2. Never place the magnet nearby device's LED continually, it would cause device to be in unknown mode and consume the extra power consumption.



4.3 Parameter Settings via Android/iOS App

We use Android App's operation as an example for chapter 4.3 and 4.4.

- 2. Make sure you turn on BLE for mobile device and open LT-10 App.
- 3. Turn on device by putting magnetic under device's LED for 4 seconds, it would blink Red 3 times.
- 4. Putting magnetic under device's LED for 2 seconds till you see Red LED blink twice. Then move magnetic to be far from device.



5. Click **Scan** button, it will search for LT-10 device and click it which you would like to do settings as the following left picture. After pairing with the device, it would get settings.

6. Then FW version, LoRa MAC, device battery level, App Version would be shown at the bottom of menu. You could modify parameters by entering into each item of menu, for example, LoRaWAN, GPS, and Operation Mode etc.

7. When entering into LoRaWAN settings, you could modify Join Mode, DevAddr, AppSKey, NwkSKey, Tx_Band etc. Please adjust these settings according to network server's settings carefully. Otherwise, it will cause network server connection issue. After modifying all the settings, click **Apply** button to write all these settings to the device.


8. You could also adjust tracker's settings by modifying some parameters in GPS/ Operation Mode/Other Setting and click **Apply** button to write your settings to device.






4.4 Firmware Upgrade via Android/iOS App

I. Put firmware file to mobile phone

 Connect your Android mobile phone and drop the firmware zip file (for example, F-0LR-49-2111181_dfu.zip) to a proper location, for example, the folder of SD card's 'Download'.






II. Upgrade Firmware via Android App

- 1. Make sure you turn on BLE for mobile device and open LT-10 App.
- 2. Turn on device by putting magnetic under device's LED for 4 seconds, it would blink Red 3 times.
- 3. Putting magnetic under device's LED for 2 seconds till you see Red LED blink twice. Then move magnetic to be far from device.
- 4. Click **Scan** button, it will search for LT-10 device and click it which you would like to do settings as the following left picture. After pairing with the device, it would get settings.


